Under the frame of green house abatements projects to be ratified by the Ministry of Environment following Kyoto Protocol in this respect, Arab Fertilizers & Chemicals Industries company – KEMAPCO, invites the qualified local and international entities specialized in CDM projects to participate in this tender to reduce the N<sub>2</sub>O emissions from its Nitric Acid plant in Aqaba, on Turn key basis including but not limited to proposing, designing, supplying, installing, commissioning, operating and maintaining the Technical Solution, and generating, marketing and selling or buying themselves the Certified Emissions Reductions, and financing the whole project during its whole contractual period, in accordance with the Instructions to the Tenderers and the Works documents attached to this invitation and also to the following:

1. The Tenderer shall have a similar experience and track record in similar projects.
2. The tenderers (and naturally the one who will win the tender) shall be the only responsible party to finance the whole project during its contractual period, including the, capital cost, registrations cost, operation and marketing costs and to pay any fees and all taxes either locally or internationally during the Contract period.
3. the proposed Technical solution shall be internationally approved and registered and shall not in any means adversely affect kemapco plants or its equipment, nor shall reduce the plants productivity, efficiency or increase the production cost of its products.
4. The offers shall be submitted in sealed envelopes as clearly described in the Instructions to Tenderers. Any offer submitted open or faxed will be neglected and rejected.
5. Kemapco may choose to delete the tender or to reject all offers any time and without stating any reason and without any legal or financial liability.
6. Offers shall be valid for 120 days from the Submission day mentioned here below.
7. Offers shall be accompanied with a tender Bond of 20,000JD as required in the Instructions to Tenderers.

The project is subject to the approval of Jordanian Governmental authorities and to an international authorities regulating such projects; the wining tenderer is responsible to obtain such approvals and if such approvals are not obtained or hold then Kemapco is at liberty to postpone or to cancel the awarding or the tender/project without any legal or financial liability under any circumstances.
